

EXPO 2021 Tradeshow Freight & Liquor Advisory



Freight Advisory:

Miami-based **Expo Convention Contractors (ECC)** (no relation to ED's EXPO) has the responsibility of receiving and handling all exhibit materials and empty crates for EXPO 2021. Access to loading docks is controlled by ECC for a safe and efficient move-in and move-out. **ECC can be reached at (305) 751-1234.**

Exhibitors may hand carry display materials, if the materials can be brought into the InterContinental Hotel in one trip, but exhibitors will not be able to use the freight docks unless their material is handled by ECC. The use of dollies, flat trucks, and other mechanical equipment is not permitted by exhibitors. ECC will not be responsible for any material they do not handle.

ECC handling charges (drayage) are based on the weight of the freight. Shipments are billed by the hundred weight and rounded up to the nearest hundred. Please see the Material Handling form on the [Expo Convention Contractors EXPO 2021 website link](#).

- Freight deliveries sent directly to the InterContinental Hotel will be received by ECC on exhibitor move-in days only.
- Freight deliveries sent directly to the InterContinental Hotel are subject to ECC freight handling charges regardless of the consignee as ECC is the official show contractor.
- If your freight arrives at the InterContinental Hotel prior to the published move-in dates, the facility will take possession of the item(s) and charges will be incurred from the facility in addition to ECC material handling charges.
- Advanced shipments (arriving before May 17) should be sent and labeled as follows:

Liquor Advisory:

The InterContinental Hotel is the sole provider of food and beverage on property. However, they will allow EXPO 2021 Exhibitors to hand out samples at their booth. They will not charge exhibitors a corkage or service fee for handing out beverages or food items (for products manufactured or produced by the exhibitor) as long as the samples are two (2) ounces for beverages and one (1) ounce for food.

If you are handing out a full beer, a full glass of wine, a full cocktail or a full bottle/can of water or an energy drink, you will be charged a corkage and service fee. Also, if you are handing out alcoholic beverages from your booth, you will need to hire a InterContinental Hotel bartender to handle the alcoholic beverage (it's the law).
